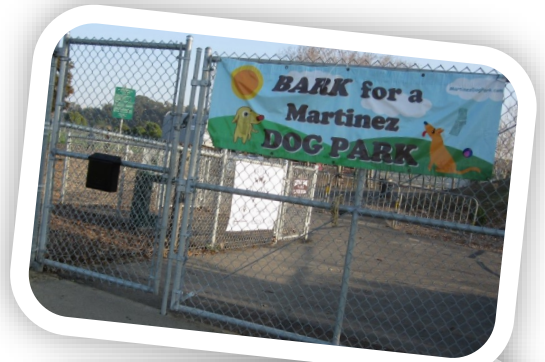
### City Council Approves Temporary Dog Park Site!

The Martinez City Council adopted Resolution No. 039-17 on April 5, 2017, which designated the John Muir Amphitheater (also known as the Martinez Waterfront Amphitheater) as a Temporary Dog Park Site for a period of up to three years from the first date of public use, and allocated \$50,000 to help fund necessary improvements.

Since receiving City Council approval to proceed, City staff transformed portions of the Amphitheater into a Temporary Dog Park, which opened to the public on July 14, 2017. This exciting space near the marina has become a communal spot for dog owners in the area and is enjoyed by many dog-loving enthusiasts.

### Dog Park Rules and Regulations:

- Dog handlers and owners must be at least 16 years of age.
- Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Each owner or handler is limited to no more than 3 dogs.
- Dogs must be at least six months old, up-to-date on all vaccinations and free of contagious conditions, with current licensing and or registration tags displayed on their collar. Dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Owners and handlers are legally responsible for the behavior of their dogs at all times. Aggressive dogs must be immediately removed.
- Owners and handlers must be within the dog park and supervising their dogs with leash readily available. Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park.
- Dog owners and handlers must immediately clean up after their dogs and dispose of waste in the provided trash receptacles.
- Any violation of section shall be an infraction as set forth in section 1.12.030 (a)(2) of the Martinez municipal code. In addition to the penalties set forth in section 1.12.030, for a third of subsequent offense within any 12 month period, The offender's right to use the designated dog park facility shall be suspended for a period of six consecutive months.
