**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINEZ ADOPTING CITY COUNCIL GOALS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023-24 AND 2024-25**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held a Goal Setting Workshop on Saturday, February 25, 2023, to discuss and update the City Council's goals for fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes there are many important issues in our community and serving the community effectively requires discipline and focus on the use of resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has identified four City Goals that will shape the development of the Biennial Budget for fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 and focus the City's resources and attention over the next fiscal cycle.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Martinez hereby adopts the following City Goals to aid in the development of the Biennial Budget for fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25:

1. Staff recruitment and retention
2. Financial sustainability
3. Vibrant sustainable waterfront and marina
4. Strong downtown and commercial centers

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council in partnership with the City Manager will commit to these goals by taking the following measures:

1. Citing consistency with the City Goals where applicable in staff reports and in resolutions to ensure alignment with City decisions.
2. Drafting the upcoming two-year budget with the City Goals at the forefront.
3. Reporting to the City Council during mid-year and mid-cycle budget updates the City's progress to meet these goals.
