## LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2000-2 (TERRA VISTA) ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24

**WHEREAS,** on July 5, 2000, the City Council of the City of Martinez, California, pursuant to the provisions of the California Streets and Highway Code Section 22500 et seq. (the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972), adopted Resolution No. 84-00 determining to initiate proceedings to levy an annual assessment for the landscaping, lighting, drainage and paving improvements of the Assessment District No. 2000-2; and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer, Engineer of Work for Assessment District No. 2000-2, City of Martinez, Contra Costa County, California makes this Engineer's Report, as directed by the City Council, pursuant to California Streets and Highway Code Section 22500 et seq. (the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972) and Section 4(b) of Article XIIID to the California Constitution (Proposition 218); and

**WHEREAS**, the maintenance of landscaping, lighting, drainage, and pavement improvements that are the subject of this Engineer's Report are briefly described as follows:

- 1. Natural vegetation planting areas in the scenic easements and public right-of-way along the subdivision frontage of Hidden Lakes Drive.
- 2. Streetlights in the public right-of-way of Lance Court and at its intersection with Hidden Lakes Drive.
- 3. Paving and curbs within a portion of the emergency vehicle access easement within Contra Costa County Subdivision No. 8265, Terra Vista. The landscaping within the emergency vehicle access easement will be maintained by the private property owner.
- 4. Drainage culverts and facilities within the scenic easements.

WHEREAS, the estimated amount to be paid for said improvements, including maintenance and servicing thereof and the costs and expenses incidental thereto, to be paid by the Assessment District for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 is as follows:

The Plans and Specification as required by said Act were prepared as separate instruments, are on file in the office of the City Clerk and are incorporated herein by reference.

As required by said Act, a diagram is hereto attached showing the Assessment District and also the boundaries and dimensions of the respective lots or parcels of land within said Assessment District as the same as on the latest available County Assessor's Map.

The amount assessed and the number of the assessment is placed opposite the number of each lot or parcel of land. Each lot or parcel of land is described in the assessment list by reference to its parcel number as shown on the Assessor's Maps of the County of Contra Costa for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 to the right of the parcel numbers and includes all of such parcel.
