

CITY OF MARTINEZ CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS RECYCLING ORDINANCE WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN (WMP)

ATTENTION: City of Martinez C&D Recycling Ordinance requires diversion of job-site debris from the landfill. The current CALGreen Building Code standard requires 65% diversion. A security deposit of 1% of the projected project cost or \$500, whichever is greater, is required at the time of permit application. In addition, a one-time, non-refundable administrative fee of \$130, equivalent to one hour of pre-work or site inspection City staff time, is also required.
